ABOUT US:

Save Generations Organization (SGO), is a Rwandan Development Non-Government Organization (NGO) dedicated to promote and advocate for child and women's rights in order to prepare, empower and equip the future generations. Save Generations Organization has been established in 2015 and is registered at Rwanda Governance Board (RGB) with legal personality number 008/RGB/NGO/2016, issued in 2016.

To create space and provide opportunities to children, youth, and women for their integral development and healthy life and to enable them reach their full potential.

In the year 2020, Save Generations Organization intervened in different domains including Education, Adolescents and Youth Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (AYSRHR) and Family Planning (FP), Youth and women's empowerment and livelihoods improvement, Child protection and wellbeing, Environment protection and climate change resilience and Emergence Responses by Implementing different projects, funded by different partners.

IN THE DOMAIN OF ADOLESCENTS AND YOUTH SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND RIGHTS (AYSRHR) AND FAMILY PLANNING (FP)

Save Generations Organization Funded by Kviina Till Kvinna implemented a project on Empowerment of adolescents and young girls in school on Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR) in Gasabo and Kamonyi Districts. The project intends to increase knowledge and information on SRHR to adolescents and youth in school in order to enable them make informed and responsible choices and decisions over their bodies as well as to exercise their SRH rights. The project is implemented in the

schools in Gasabo and Kamonyi Districts. In Gasabo District, it works in Rusororo sector (GS Kabuga) and Ndera sector (GS Ndera); and in Kamonyi District, in Rukoma sector (GS Bugoba) and Ngamba Sector (GS Ngamba). The project reached directly to 328 including 200 girls and 40 boys between 10–19 years from 4 high schools, 40 parents (21 women and 19 men), 28 teachers (15 women & 13 men) and local leaders, 20 journalists; And also worked indirectly with 188736 Beneficiaries including SRHR app users and Radio talk show followers. Throughout the implementation of this project, different activities have been implemented among them there are:

Identification of new project participants

In February 2020, Save Generations Organization identified and recruited new project participants to replace the outgoing from P6, S3, and S6, those participants include 61 girls and 14 boys totaling to 240 adolescents, including 200 girls and 40 boys



between 10–19 years from 4 high schools; and in the community, targeting parents, teachers, religious leaders and local leaders. This aimed at increasing the involvement of different beneficiaries in the project.

Developing, multiplication and distribution of SRHR Information, Education & Communication (IEC) materials.



Save Generations Organization developed, multiplied and distributed SRHR IEC materials (1410 booklets) for children 10-12 years and 13-19 years, 100 booklets for parents and teachers in Gasabo and Kamonyi Districts on SRHR in line with CSE, Child rights, and positive parenting to increase their engagement and support for SRHR promotion.

SRHR Booklets

Training of Journalists



Save Generations Organization funded by Kvinna Till Kvinna conducted a training to 20 journalists including 12 women & 8 men on SRHR and child rights from different media houses including print online media, Radio stations and TV stations in consideration of the role of media in raising awareness and life transformation of the people. The trainings aimed to increase their knowledge and information on SRHR and child rights and to enable them share accurate information to adolescents, youth and community in general through media. This resulted to publication of over 32 SRHR articles and 10 interventions in Radio & TV station talk shows on SRHR

Awareness on Menstrual Hygiene Management and distribution of MHM materials.

Save Generations Organization funded by Kvinna Till Kvinna raised awareness and provided menstrual hygiene products (sanitary pads and soaps) to 200 adolescents and young girls' right holders in GS Ngamba and Bugoba in Kamonyi district southern province, GS Kabuga, and GS Ndera in Gasabo district towards response of period poverty among girls 'project right holders during school closure due to COVID-19

where 1200 Menstrual Hygiene Materials (sanitary pads) and 600 bars of soap in total were provided to young girls between the age of 10-19 years during the period of 3 months of the lockdown while at home.

Save Generations Organization in partnership with Paper Crown conducted SRHR Training in Bugesera District to 40 young adolescents, including 20 girls and 20 boys gained accurate information on SRHR.



Digital Advocacy & Awareness on girls go back to school

In October 2020, Save Generations Organization funded by Kvinna Till Kvinna conducted advocacy meetings on girls go back to school awareness campaign in Kamonyi district & Gasabo district.



The meeting was attended by 80 stakeholders from Kamonyi and Gasabo districts, including Government institutions (MINEDUC, GMO, NCC), Local government authorities, school leaders, parents and children participated in advocacy meeting, discussed on challenges of covid 19 to education especially girl's education and proposed solutions responding to the challenges hence playing part in returning affected Girls Back to School. This motivated many to help Girls return back to school after school re-opening.

SRHR



Mobile Technology application (845 SRHR mobile phone services)

Save Generations Organization funded by Kvinna till Kvinna in partnership with VIAMO (a Canadian Social Enterprise) & in collaboration with other KTK partners (Rwanda Women Network, Réseau des Femmes, UNABU) developed an SRHR Mobile Technology Application called “845 – SRHR Mobile Technology services” to ease and increase access to SRHR accurate information to adolescents and youth.



This application targets directly 1,434 right holders in 12 districts including Gasabo, Kamonyi, Rwamagana, Kayanza, Bugesera, Musanze, Rubavu, Nyagatare, Bugesera, Gicumbi, Nyanza, Rutsiro, and Burera and indirectly it's accessed by over 1.5 Million Rwandans & abroad the majority being the youth. This app helps in reducing myths on SRHR by dissemination of accurate information on a wider range hence easy and affordable access to SRHR information with social gatherings.

Radio program

Save Generations Organization funded by Kvinna till Kvinna initiated a Radio talk show program called “Tuganire ku Buzima bw’Imyorokere” or “Let’s talk on SRHR” started on Radio Flash FM (89.2FM) Rwanda. Where the program was broadcasted every Sunday from



24 radio talk shows have been conducted on different topics, the show targeted 308 beneficiaries (children, parents, Teachers & local leaders, and also millions of Rwandans in the country and abroad. This radio talk show helped much in dissemination of accurate SRHR information during these tough periods of the covid-19 pandemic. Education Program

High School Sponsorship Program.

Save Generations Organization funded by A Bridge for Girls Fund, fully paid school fees to 8 High school Girls in this program and provided them with COVID19 protective materials & Menstrual Hygiene Materials to overcome period poverty as they were returning back to school. This helped them return back to school after their families being hit by COVID19 pandemic.



BUGESERA DISTRICT

In Rweru IDP Model Village Save Generations Organization funded by AHF provided basic scholastic materials including books and pens to 94 school girls and boys who were preparing to return back to school.



YOUTH AND WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT AND LIVELIHOODS IMPROVEMENT

SGO SRHR Capacity Building Trainings



Save Generations Organizations in partnership with Shelther Them Batarure provided capacity building trainings on Entrepreneurship & personal development skills to 37 youth and adults beneficiaries. This helped them raise change their mindsets towards creativity hence hence gained knowledge and skills on saving and starting small medium enterprises

EMERGENCE INTERVENTIONS

SGO COVID - 19 prevention campaigns & provision of protective materials.

GASABO & KAMONYI DISTRICT

Save Generations Organization in response to Covid-19 prevention Funded by Kvinna Till Kvinna, conducted awareness campaigns on COVID-19 prevention in its districts of intervention kamonyi & Gasabo and Provided covid19 basic protective materials to adolescents and youth in its programs and their families,



1216 facemasks and 240 bars of soap, these materials contributed to the prevention of Covid19 during and after the lock down.



Save Generations Organization also distributed Hand sanitizers to the teachers who act as focal persons to the adolescent girls and boys while at school,



and 8 phones to focal persons and peer educators in the schools of GS Bugoba & Ngamba in Kamonyi district and GS Ndera & Kabuga in Gasabo District for sensitization and usage of SRHR mobile application and easy daily follow up on the adolescent Girls and Boys. This increased the access of accurate SRHR information via mobile phones.



BUGESERA DISTRICT

Save Generations Organization in partnership with A Bridge for Girls Fund & Friends of SGO conducted an awareness campaign on COVID-19 prevention and provided basic preventive materials which include 1000 face masks and 300 bar soaps to 298 households' of 1777 citizens in Rweru IDP modal village.



COVID 19 Food Emergency Response in Bugesera District.

Save Generations Organization Funded by AHF provided 3 tons of food which include posho, beans and rice, to 100 households severely affected by Covid-19 in Rweru IDP model village located in Bugesera District, Eastern Province.



In November 2020, Save Generations Organization Funded by Rwanda Green Fund, FONERWA launched and started implementing a new project entitled "Empowerment of women and youth to climate change resilience and environmental protection in Nyagatare district" which aims to empower women and youth for climate change resilience and environment conservation through biomass replacement and wastes management by providing cooking stoves and briquettes to reduce deforestation, gender-based violence and create green jobs to youths in 5 sectors of Nyagatare District (Rwimiyaga, Nyagatare, Tabagwe, Mimuri and Karangazi sector).



The project will construct 5 cooking stove plants & 1 briquette plant, distribute 6000 cooking stoves to 6000 selected households in the 5 sectors hence providing 108 tons of briquettes to 600 most vulnerable households and also training 200 youth in cooperatives (100 females, 100 male) on how to make cooking stoves and briquettes hence green job creation to the youth & women cooperatives. 4 Capacity building sessions with youth cooperatives to raise their knowledge on cooperative management have so far been conducted.

Upcoming interventions >>>

- Implementation of the 2 Years SRHR Project 2021-2022 in Gasabo and Kamonyi Districts on Empowerment of Adolescents and Young Girls in school on Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights in partnership with Kvinna till Kvinna.
- Continuation of the implementation of a one year project on Environment and Climate change resilience in Nyagatare District , Eastern Province funded by FONERWA.
- Emergence interventions where needed with availability of Funds.
- Keep looking for other funding opportunities that fit in our domains of interventions for community transformation
